Stratford-on-Avon District Sports Awards

Stratford-on-Avon District Council created the Sport Awards to recognise sporting achievement and to celebrate the huge amount of work that takes place within sport in the Stratford-on-Avon District.

The 2012 event, sponsored by the Holiday Inn, NFU Mutual and Everyone Active, will be the 10th anniversary of the awards with a special Olympic themed celebration dinner planned to include local Olympians, past and present, alongside our stars of the future.

All nominations need to be submitted to the Council offices by the **16th December 2011**. You can also nominate online at www.stratford.gov.uk/sportsawards.

An independent panel will sit to decide the finalists. Once decided upon the finalists will be profiled by the Stratford Herald newspaper with the winner being announced at the awards dinner on 2nd March 2012.

This year some of the category winners will be decided from a public vote from forms submitted either through the Herald newspaper or on-line at www.stratford.gov.uk/sportsawards.

- ★ All finalists in each category will be invited to the Awards evening so make sure you put the date in your diary!
- ★ All categories are fully inclusive and open to disabled or non-disabled people.
- ★ All achievements to be considered must be from 2011 with the exception of the Service to Sport category.
- ★ All nominations must be received by **16th December 2011**. Entries received after this date will not be considered.
- ★ All nominees must live or go to school within the Stratford District and compete for, or work with, a club or school team.
- ★ You may only nominate a person in **one** category unless they are also part of a team.



Nomination Categories and Criteria

★ NFU Mutual Community Award

This award will be made to a person or persons who have made a significant contribution to the Community through sport in 2011.

★ Junior Sports Person

This category is open to girls and boys aged 17 and under as at 31st December 2011.

★ Senior Sports Person

This category is open to individuals 18 years & over as at 31st December 2011.

★ Junior Team of the Year

This category is open to teams of 2 (ie; doubles in tennis) and above. A school team can be either primary or secondary. All team members must be aged 17 & under as at 31st December 2011.

(Exception: School teams may include pupils who turn 18 by 31st August 2012 ie; 6th form students and school year 2010/2011 can be highlighted)



★ Club Volunteer / Club Administrator

This category is open to individuals who have made a large voluntary commitment or contribution to the day to day running and administration of a club throughout 2011 or in the competitive season 2010/2011.

★ Service to Sport Award

The Service to Sport category is for an individual who has made a notable contribution to sport within the Stratford-on-Avon District over many years with one or more clubs or sports. This is an award to that special someone who has enriched many sports lives along the way.

★ Senior Team of the Year

This category is also open to teams of 2 or more people. All team members should be 18 years or over by 31st December 2011. (Exception: Teams of 6 people or more ie; Basketball, Rugby etc may include no more than two under 18's).

★ "Alternative" Sport Award

This category is open to teams or individuals who have excelled at their sport or pastime in 2011. Sports in this category are not supported by Sport England ie dance troupes / skipping / skateboarding / rollerblading / wakeboarding etc.

★ Club or Individual Coach / School P.E. Teacher

The coach or P.E teacher may be a voluntary or paid position but the person must have made a significant contribution to improving the standard of an individual, club or school in any sport within 2011. *(Exception - school year 2010/2011 can be highlighted)*
