DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARDS
TRANSPORT SCHEMES IN STRATFORD-UPON-AVON

The Council, on 5 December 2011, formally adopted amendments to the above Supplementary Planning Document (SPD).

Any persons aggrieved by the amendments to the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt them. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the amendments to the SPD were adopted.

The purpose of the amendments is to update the list of schemes identified in the SPD for which developer contributions are collected in accordance with the provisions of the SPD.
