ADOPTION STATEMENT

**SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT
MANAGING HOUSING SUPPLY**

The Council, on 13 November 2006, formally adopted the above Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) that relates to the whole of the District.

Any persons aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.

The purpose of the SPD is to control the release of housing sites within the District in order to restrict any over supply, whilst specifying the circumstances in which housing proposals will be permitted because of the appreciable benefits they have for either the local community and/or the environment.
