Ladies and Girls Football

Southam United Football Club have pioneered girls and ladies football in the region since the early nineties. With teams to cater for girls of all ages, Southam United have lead the way in developing the sport on and off the field.

Southam United feature girls teams in the Central Warwickshire and Coventry District leagues, the ladies play in the premier division of the West Midlands regional league.

The girls and ladies have bought many honours to the club during this time, staffed by a small band of hard working volunteers who help to offer a range of facilities at the club including F.A. qualified coaches.

With girls football becoming very popular more clubs have included girls teams in the county, leaving Southam with a very small catchment area.



In the girls section at present we run U16 at eleven a side, U14 at seven a side, for the coming season, ideally we would like to be able to include an U12 seven a side. Unfortunately if we do not manage to entice more girls all the age groups some girls will miss out on playing football at Southam in the 2007 / 2008 season.

After more than a decade of hard work, Southam United are now appealing for new recruits across the club. Girls and ladies of all ages are welcome to come along and join this friendly and expanding club.
