parking options available for over 60's free swimming



Q When does the free swimming come into force?

A Customers over the age of 60 are able to take advantage of free swimming at their local swimming pool from 1 April 2009.

Q How has this come about?

A The free swimming for over 60's is a Government funded initiative that will run till 31 March 2011.

Q Do I have to pay to park?

A Yes! A valid pay and display ticket must be purchased and displayed for the whole period that you are parked in the car park

Full Leisure Centre and Swim Members	If you pay by annual or monthly direct debit you can purchase a Leisure Centre Parking Permit for use in Riverside Car Park for a maximum period of 4 hours only when using the Leisure Centre facilities.
Residents of Stratford District	Value Parking Cards to the value of £30 and £12 are available for purchase from our Council offices. The costs of these cards are £10 and £5 respectively.
Concessionary bus pass	Holders of a valid concessionary bus pass can use the local bus services as well as the park and ride.
Concessionary Parking Pass	If you are over the age of 65, hold a valid driving license and are resident within the District you may apply for a Concessionary Parking Pass for use in the Recreation Ground Car Park. There is an administration cost of £10 applicable for the issue of a Concessionary Parking Pass.
District Council car parks	Depending on your usage of the District Council car parks, you may find that purchasing a Season ticket will be of benefit to you. Based on the current pricing structure, an annual permit used over a period of 5 days has a daily cost of £1.92
District Council Car Parks	Alternatively, you can purchase a pay and display ticket from any of the machines situated in the car park.
