The Council, on 23 April 2007, formally adopted the above Supplementary Planning Documents (SPDs).

The Developer Contributions Towards Transport Schemes in Stratford-upon-Avon SPD sets out a methodology to secure developer contributions for transport schemes in Stratford-upon-Avon in accordance with the transport strategy of the Local Plan Review and the Local Transport Plan for Warwickshire.

The Car and Cycle Parking Standards SPD sets out detailed parking standards for all forms of development across the District.

The Local Choice – meeting the needs of Rural Communities SPD provides detailed guidance on the operation of Policy COM.1 'Local Choice' of the Local Plan Review. It also provides guidance on the role of Parish Plans and the local community in identifying and meeting local needs for development.
