## **Application for the designation of a Neighbourhood Plan Area by Quinton Parish Council.**

On 18<sup>th</sup> September 2014, Quinton Parish Council resolved to apply for designation of a neighbourhood area in accordance with Regulation 5 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. Please accept this letter as a formal application to Stratford on Avon District Council for this designation.

In compliance with the requirements of regulation 5 we include a map showing the area delineated by the Parish boundary of the Parish. This will be the area to which this application relates. The area covered by this application is the whole of the Parish and does not intrude into any adjoining Parish. We consider our Parish boundary of Quinton Parish in its entirety to be appropriate to define the Neighbourhood Plan Area. It is recognised that there will be a need to consult with our neighbouring parishes on all appropriate sites where there is a mutual interest, in particular with Marston Sicca Parish Council in relation to the Long Marston Airfield.

This application for designation of a neighbourhood area is submitted by Quinton Parish Council which, as a Parish Council, is a relevant body for the purposes of this matter and is defined as such under Section 61G (2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

Quinton Parish Council is in the process of forming a neighbourhood plan working group which will comprise local residents, businesses and Parish Councillors. This group will take the lead in preparing the neighbourhood plan for this area and has the Parish Council's full support.

Quinton Parish Council formally requests that Stratford-on-Avon District Council, as the local planning authority, publicises this application in accordance with regulation 6 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. We confirm that no previous application has been made for this area.

I would be grateful if you could acknowledge receipt of this application and indicate the timescale for publicising the application and the decision to accept or reject.
