WILMCOTE AND PATHLOW DRAFT NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN SEA/HRA CONSULTATION

Thank you for the above consultation.

For the purposes of consultations on SEA, Historic England confines its advice to the question, "Is the Plan or proposal likely to have a significant effect on the environment?" in respect of our area of concern, cultural heritage. Our comments are based on the information supplied by the LPA in their consultation to us.

On the basis of the information supplied, including that set out in the draft plan, and in the context of the criteria set out in Schedule 1 of the Environmental Assessment Regulations [Annex II of 'SEA' Directive], Historic England concur with the Council and are of the opinion that the preparation of a Strategic Environmental Assessment is currently not necessary.

The views of the other statutory consultation bodies should be taken into account before the overall decision on the need for a SEA is made. If a decision is made to undertake a SEA, please note that Historic England has published guidance on Sustainability Appraisal / Strategic Environmental Assessment and the Historic Environment that is relevant to both local and neighbourhood planning and available at: <http://www.english-heritage.org.uk/publications/strategic-environmental-assessment-sustainability-appraisal-historic-environment/>.

As regards the HRA Assessment English Heritage does not wish to comment in detail and would defer to Natural England and other statutory consultees.
