Application for the designation of a Neighbourhood Plan Area by Wellesbourne and Walton Parish Council

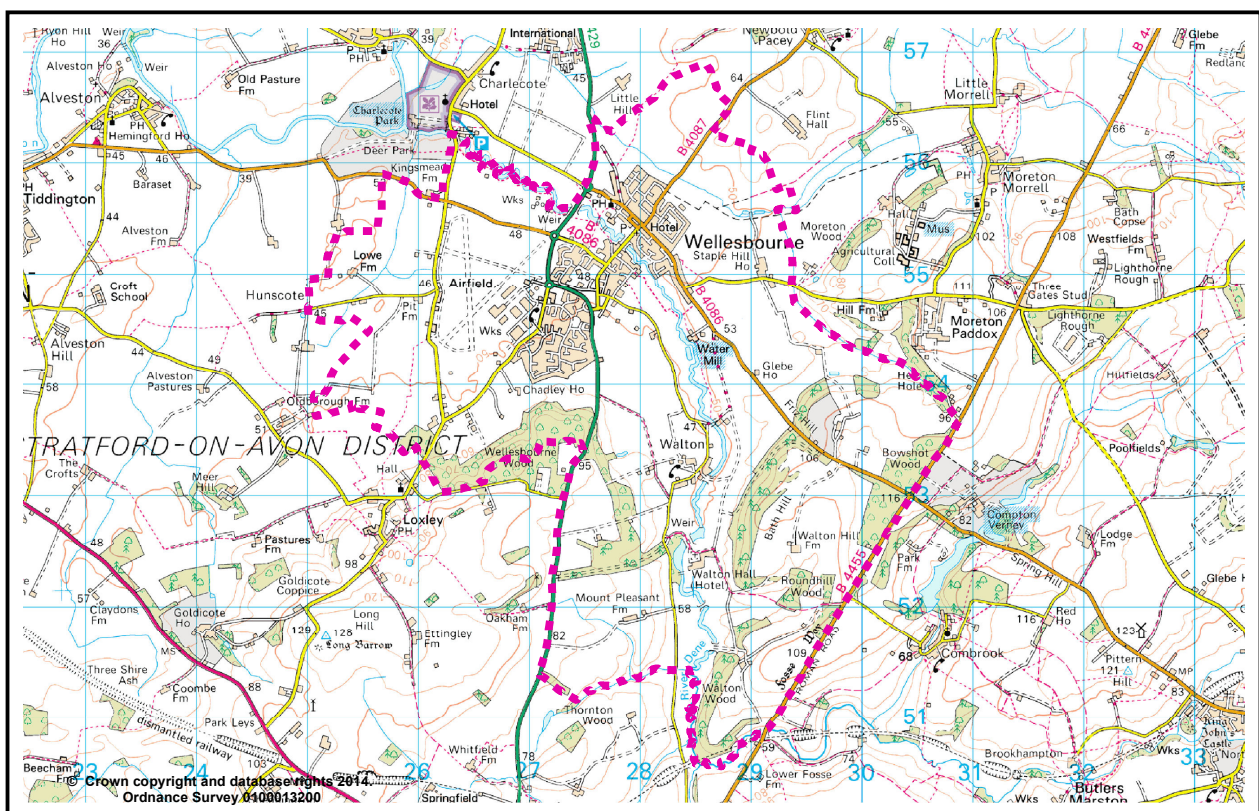
Notice is given that Stratford-on-Avon District Council has received from the Wellesbourne and Walton Parish Council an application under Part 2, Regulation 5 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, to designate the area comprising the civil parish of Wellesbourne and Walton as a neighbourhood within the meaning of section of Section 61G of 1990 Act (see explanatory note below).

Explanatory Note

Following the introduction of the Localism Act 2011, the purpose of designating a Neighbourhood Area is for a Neighbourhood Plan to then be prepared for that area. The Wellesbourne and Walton Parish Council is currently preparing a Neighbourhood Plan and this application now seeks to formalise the process.
