Stratford-on-Avon District Local Industrial and Economic Development Strategy 2018-2031



At Stratford-on-Avon's Council meeting on 17 December 2018, Members decided to adopt the Stratford-on-Avon District Local Industrial and Economic Development Strategy 2018-2031. The Strategy seeks to increase productivity across the District and includes an Action Plan setting out what interventions SDC and its partners should make to achieve indigenous business growth, retention and new inward investment.

Reasons for decision:

This is the first Local Industrial and Economic Development Strategy prepared by the District Council. It fits within a hierarchy of such strategies from National through regional, subregional down to this local level. At each level more local information is incorporated so that it becomes of greater local relevance. Its continued relevance will be maintained by monitoring and annual review of the action plan and Strategy every five years.
