
STRATFORD-UPON-AVON

BYE-LAW

made under Section 164 of the Public Health Act, 1875, by the Stratford-on-Avon District Council with respect to the Bancroft Gardens and The Tramway in the former Borough of Stratford-upon-Avon.

The Series of Byelaws with respect to the Pleasure Ground known as The Bancroft Pleasure Ground made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Stratford-upon-Avon, acting by the Council, on the 8th day of October, 1901, and allowed by the Local Government Board on the 17th day of October, 1901, is hereby extended to apply to the whole area of land known as the Bancroft Gardens and to that piece of land known as The Tramway and the Byelaws shall be read and construed accordingly.


