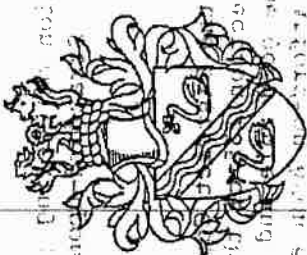

## BYELAW for the Prevention of Cycling on the Tramway Bridge

### TRAMWAY BRIDGE STRATFORD-UPON-AVON

These byelaws are made by the Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 107 of the Local Government Act 1936 and for the purpose of preventing the use of the Tramway Bridge as a cycle track.

These byelaws were made at a meeting of the Council held on the 12th day of July 1956 and were passed by a majority of the Council.

STRATFORD-ON-AVON DISTRICT COUNCIL

BYELAW

for the Prevention of Cycling on the Tramway Bridge,  
Stratford-upon-Avon

Byelaw made by the District Council of Stratford-upon-Avon under Section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 for the good rule and government of the District of Stratford-upon-Avon and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

- 1(1) A person shall not, except in the exercise of any lawful right or privilege ride a bicycle, tricycle or other similar machine on the footpath known as the Tramway Bridge.
- 1(2) Notice of the effect of this byelaw shall be given by signs placed in such positions as the Council may consider adequate to inform persons using the Tramway Bridge.
- 2 Any person offending against this byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds.
- 3 The byelaw made by the Borough of Stratford-upon-Avon on 12th July 1949 is revoked with effect from the date on which this byelaw shall come into operation.
