RESIDENTS SURVEY TOPLINE WEIGHTED

FINAL RESULTS 2019

The survey used postal self-completion questionnaires. The electoral roll was used and the questionnaire went to the householder to give a random sample. This way, around one in ten households in the District received the questionnaire. The methodology included one reminder mailing implemented within the prescribed timescale between early October and early December 2019. 6,000 questionnaires were despatched, with 1,804 questionnaires returned in the timescale allowed, a 30.2% response rate (taking out 27 "return to senders etc.").

This document shows the final results of the whole survey, excluding don't know etc where appropriate, as per the industry norm. Although these are results in isolation, it gives an idea of current resident perceptions and thoughts, with the detailed report to follow.

The results are **weighted**. Weighting is by age, gender, ethnicity and household size in line with previous residents' surveys.
