EWA1264 - A site visit to the Maze 100m west of 'The Hill' was made by Warwickshire County Council on the 29th June 1979. The maze was overgrown but still visible. Ridge and Furrow region.

MWA7243 - An archaeological evaluation uncovered features dating to the Iron Age/Roman period. The features, including pits and gullies, suggest that this may be the site of a settlement. MWA7218 - Mesolithic and Neolithic flint artefacts were discovered.

MWA8693 - A rabbit warren existed on Alveston Heath prior to its enclosure in the 17th/18th century, EWA9849 - The results of documents and site visits conclude that the area of the site has archaeological potential, in that there is good evidence for prehistoric/Romano-British settlement, and it is possible that similar features like the complex cropmarks found in MWA 1009, survive elsewhere on the site.

EWA10518 - eastern part of the site contained a high density of archaeological cut features with most of the excavated features containing Romano-British pottery, The Site most likely contains the significant well-preserved below ground remains of a Romano-British settlement. EWA10580 - geophysical survey - The survey identified an area of settlement thought to be of either a prehistoric or Roman date, as well as evidence for ridge and furrow cultivation
