Become a COVID-19 Youth Community Champion and help people do the right thing for Warwickshire

Do you want to support individuals in your community to be safe and well?

Training for young people who want to gain valuable skills in active citizenship. Hurry-places are limited

To attend the course you just need to meet the following criteria:

- Live or go to school/college in Warwickshire
- Be between 16- 18 years of age
- Have a passion for learning in an informal and fun environment.

Background:

The purpose of the course is to offer increased protection to the Warwickshire public, particularly young people, during the Coronavirus pandemic by providing relevant training to young people who are willing to be COVID-19 youth champions. The course offers opportunities to learn more about being active as a responsible and supportive member of your community.

Course dates:

- Tuesday 27 April 2021
 - Tuesday 4 May 2021
 - Tuesday 11 May 2021
 - Tuesday 18 May 2021
- They are all from 4:00 – 5:30pm

The course has the following key objectives:

1. To provide opportunities to learn how to be more active and involved in your community.
2. To provide opportunities to learn about the impact of the pandemic locally and how to stay safe.
3. Identify ways for young people to get information and support for others to access.
4. You will develop leadership skills that will help with University/job applications.
5. You will learn how to develop a personal action plan.

Upon completion of the course, you will receive a COVID-19 Community Champions certificate. Most importantly we at Warwickshire County Council will look forward to working with you in the future on your ideas and projects to help people do the right thing and stay safe.

Length of Course

This will be over **four consecutive weeks** starting on Tuesday 27 April. Each session will be about **90 minutes long**.
