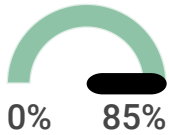

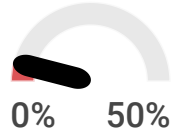

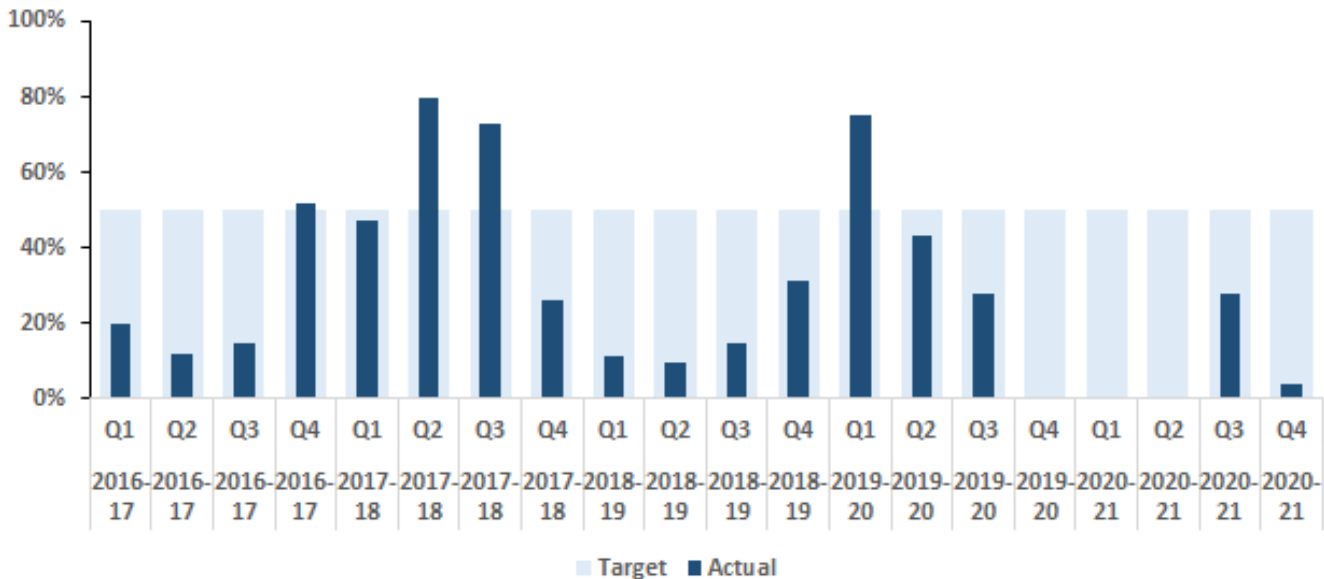

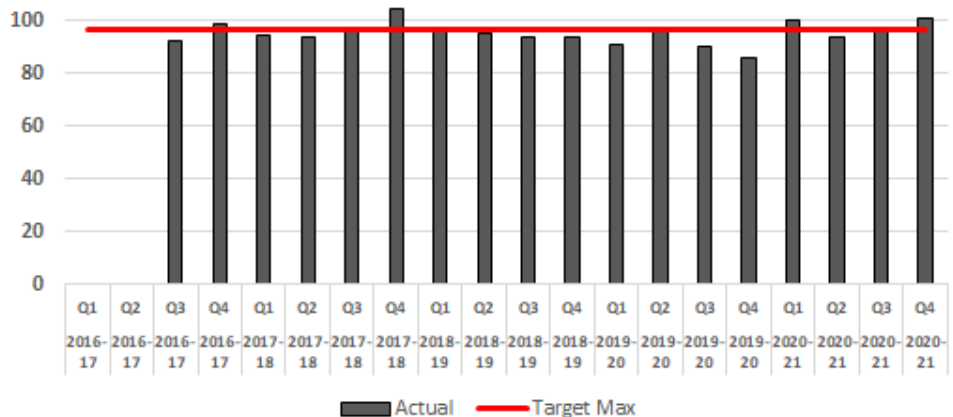
**Residual household waste per household (kg's)**



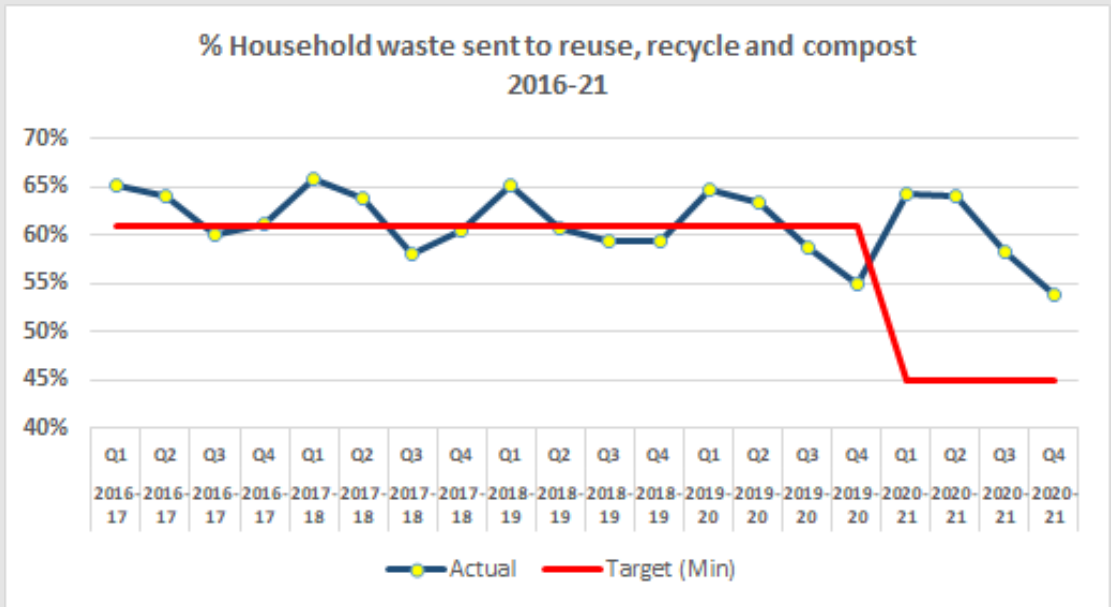
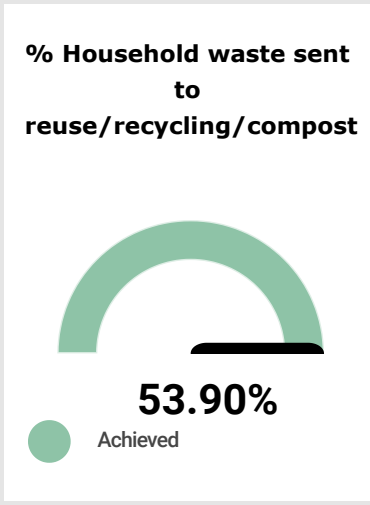

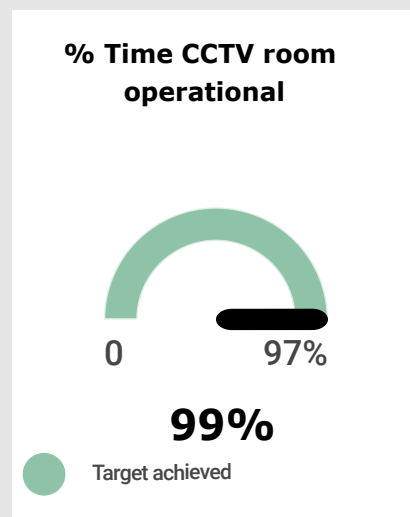
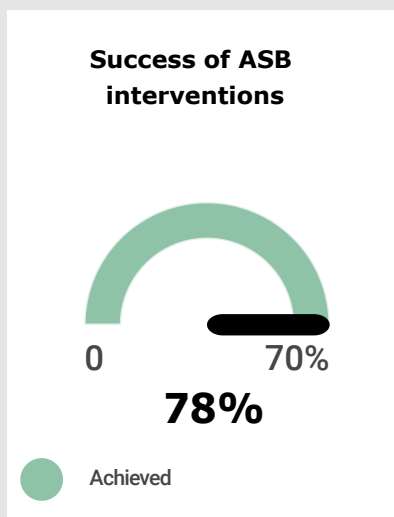
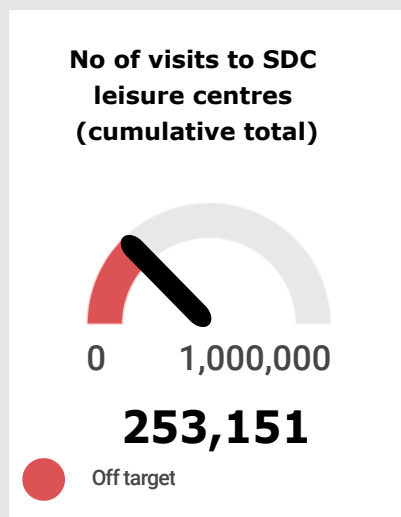
The amount of general waste and recycling increased during the Covid-19 lockdown period, particularly and increase in non-recyclable packaging from home deliveries.
