## SOUTHAM NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN SCREENING FOR STRATEGIC ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (SEA)

In accordance with the European Directive 2001/42/EC and associated Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004 (SEA Regulations), Lepus Consulting has prepared a SEA Screening Document on behalf of Stratford-on-Avon District Council to determine whether the Southam Neighbourhood Development Plan (SNDP) should be subject to a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA).

The Screening Document explored the potential effects of the proposed SNDP and concluded that on the basis of the SEA Screening Assessment, the SNDP would not result in significant environmental effects in relation to criteria set out in the SEA Regulations or the Habitats and Species Regulations.

This screening document was subsequently submitted to the statutory environmental bodies of Historic England, Environment Agency and Natural England for comment, in accordance with the SEA Regulations. The three consultees concurred with the conclusions of the Screening Document that the preparation of a SEA was not required, however there were a number of suggested recommendations by the Environment Agency which you have been notified of.

Having read the Submitted Draft NDP, SEA Screening Document and responses from the three statutory consultees, I concur with the view that a SEA is not required for the SNDP.
