



BYELAW NOTICE

The Bancroft Gardens, The Recreation Ground and The Tramway Pleasure Grounds

Notice is hereby given that Stratford-on-Avon District Council sealed the Byelaw for The Bancroft Gardens, The Recreation Ground and The Tramway pleasure grounds, Stratford-upon-Avon, on 11 January 2023 and that it will come into force on 1 February 2023.

The Byelaw, when it comes into force, revokes all previous amenity byelaws that were in place for these areas. The new Byelaw is generally based on the pleasure grounds, open spaces and walks model byelaws provided by the Department of Levelling Up, Housing and Communities, amended however, to reflect local scenarios. The objective of the Byelaw is to provide a set of rules for the effective and equitable management of the pleasure grounds.

A copy of the Byelaw will be kept at the offices of the Council at Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford-upon-Avon, CV37 6HX and will be open to inspection, without payment, on any weekday from 9am to 5pm (excluding Bank Holidays) from the publication of this notice. Copies of the Byelaw can be obtained at the offices of the Council at a cost of £5.
