1. Add the following expression to Part I, Article 4 of this Order:

"Concessionary Permit" means an annual permit issued to a Resident of state pension age by the Council in accordance with Part III, Article 1 of this Order.

- 2. Include "Annual Concessionary Permit: £50.00 (4 hours maximum stay)" in Schedule 1, Part 1 of this Order at the following car parks only:
 - Bridgeway Multi-Storey Car Park, Stratford-upon-Avon
 - Bridgeway Surface Car Park, Stratford-upon-Avon
