

**STRATFORD-ON-AVON DISTRICT COUNCIL  
OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES (VARIATION) (NO.1) ORDER 2023  
NOTICE OF MAKING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that STRATFORD-ON-AVON DISTRICT COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers has made the Stratford-on-Avon District Council Off-Street Parking Places (Variation) (No.1) Order 2023 (“the Order”). The Order varies the Stratford-on-Avon District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2023.

The effect of the Order is to:

1. Introduce an annual concessionary permit (£50.00 per annum, 4 hours maximum stay) to residents of state pension age at Bridgeway Multi-Storey Car Park and Bridgeway Surface Car Park, Stratford-upon-Avon.

The Order will come into force on 1 October 2023.

A copy of the Order and a statement of the Council’s reasons for making the Order may be inspected free of charge at the Council’s principal office at Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire, CV37 6HX between the hours of 09:00 and 17:00 Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays and public holidays). Any person wishing to challenge the validity of the Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with, may within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply to the High Court.
