

STRATFORD-UPON-AVON TOWN COUNCIL, REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY 12 NOVEMBER 2023

INTRODUCTION

Stratford-upon-Avon Town Council is responsible for organising Stratford's Act of Commemoration on Remembrance Sunday.

An official road closure is in place to ensure the safety of those participating in the procession and members of the public who may assemble on the highway outside the Remembrance Garden.

The civic procession starts at 10.35am from the Town Hall in Sheep Street, CV37 6EF along Chapel Street, Church Street and into Old Town to the Remembrance Garden, CV37 6BN. The Royal British Legion and Contingents process from Bull Street and join the civic procession from the junction of Church Street/Chestnut Walk.

Following the Service of Remembrance, the Civic Party will return to the Town Hall via Old Town, Church Street (pausing for the March Past) and Chapel Street. The Band and the Contingents will return to Bull Street via Southern Lane, Waterside, Chapel Lane, and Church Street. The Commemoration is then over.

ROADS CLOSED: 09.15am - 1.00pm

Bull Street, Chapel Lane, Church Street, College Street, Old Town, Southern Lane, Waterside.

Roads will be reopened at 1.00pm or when it is safe to do so.

Stratford Park & Ride and Stratford-upon-Avon Parkway train station operate a combined Pay and Display car park. All users will be required to purchase a car park Pay & Display ticket or have a valid season ticket displayed in their vehicle. There is no charge for Blue Badge holders when displaying a current blue badge.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The Stratford-upon-Avon train station is approximately 10 minutes from the Town Hall and there is an easy pedestrian route with dropped kerbs and tactile paving at all major road junctions.
